President Biden's 200th federal judge was confirmed May 22, 2024.

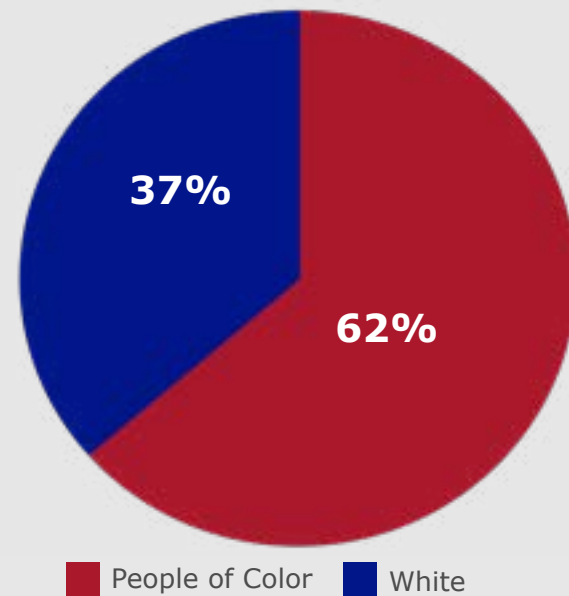
- 1 Supreme Court Justice

FOR COMPARISON

- President Trump's 200 judicial confirmations
 - » 2 Supreme Court Justices
 - » 53 Circuit Court Judges
 - » 143 District Court Judges
 - » 2 Court of International Trade Judges
- President Trump hit 200 June 24 of his fourth year. This puts President Biden slightly ahead of his predecessors' pace, but there is still work to be done.

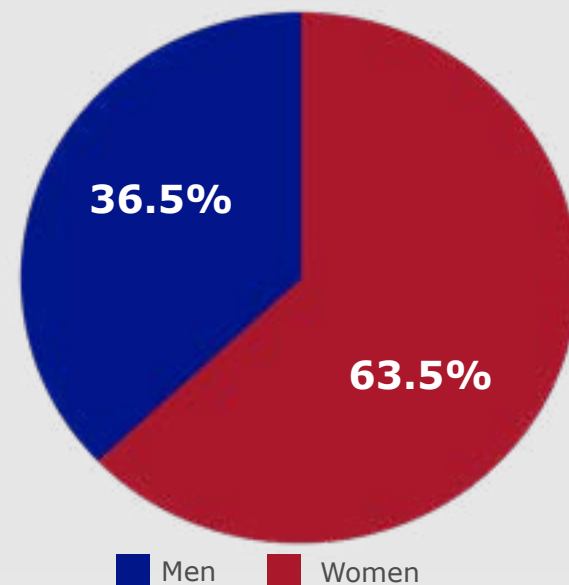
President Biden's First 200 Judges

Gender Diversity

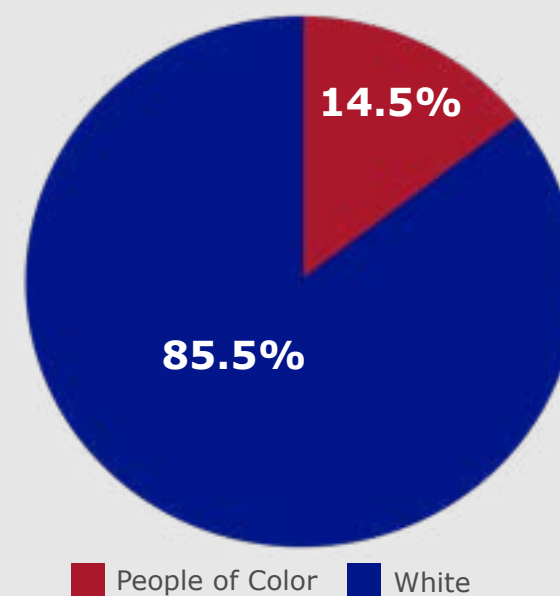

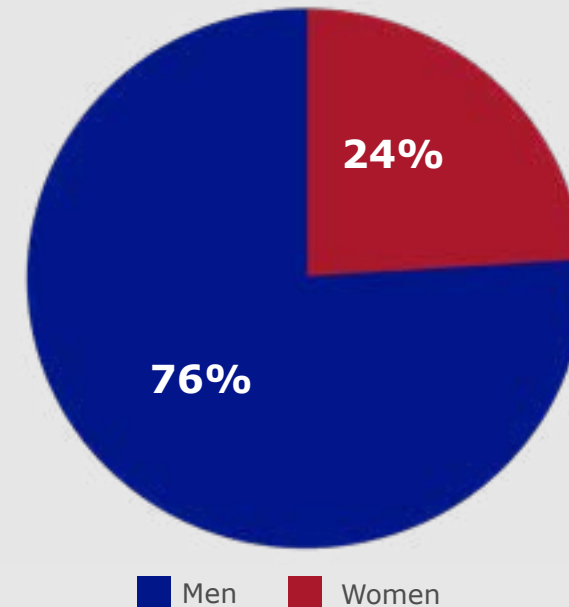


President Trump's First 200 Judges

LOOKING AHEAD

- President Trump had 234 judicial confirmations by the end of his four years.
- President Biden needs 35 more confirmations by the end of his first term to exceed the previous administration.
 - » With only 15 scheduled work weeks left for the Senate this calendar year, only 10 of which are before the election, time is running out for this goal to be achieved.
- While difficult, it is not impossible.
- As of today, there are
 - » 24 announced nominees &
 - » 45 current or known future vacancies without nominees.
- The Senate will need to maximize their time to ensure that as many of these vacancies are filled by the end of the year.
